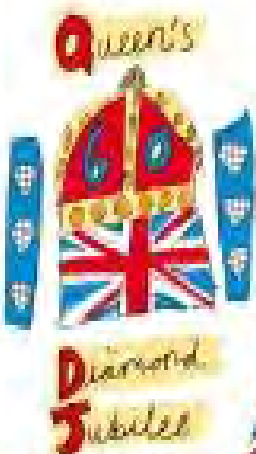
**PROGRAMME OF EVENTS**
