Friday 6th Jan 2013 – To Sat 7th Jan

Garden waste- suspended from Mon 26th Dec to restart on Mon 9th Jan 2013.

Natural Christmas trees under 6ft can be collected. If you pay for garden waste collections – put them out when normal garden waste collection restarts after the holiday period.

Otherwise, you can take to Recycling Centre or put out on normal refuse day between 9th-20th Jan.
