Parish Plan updates

Following feedback in the recent Parish Plan, the Parish Council is working on the following issues.

Highways

An Assistant Highway Service Manager spent two hours with us driving around the parish and will try to support us with better/clearer signage, clearing drains and resurfacing. Sheila Salmon (Cllr for Highways) is happy to discuss any issues with parishioners.

Police

We toured the parish with police officers to look at signage, safety, speeding and wide vehicles. They took photos of inadequate signage and dangerous areas such as Iron Mills and the narrow main road through the village. He is preparing a report to ask Highways to address these issues and we will keep you up to date with progress.

Speedwatch

The police are keen that the parish introduce a speedwatch scheme. We would like the contact details of anyone who could help. We have two people, new to the village, who have already volunteered.
